

HERITAGE TRADES PROGRAM

12 - 17 NOVEMBER, 2023

This five day training course is aimed at developing the knowledge of heritage trades amongst people who are working in the construction industry.

The program will extend their understanding of Stone Masonry, Damp Proof Courses, Repointing, Undersetting and Lime Mortar Technology.



The program is part of the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) Heritage Trades Program, and offers participants subsidised fees for eligible members.

Training

Facilitated by Keith McAllister of Applied Building Conservation Training (ABCT), the training will provide participants with the following theoretical and hands-on experience.

- **Stone Masonry**
- **Repointing**
- **Masonry Replacement (undersetting)**
- **Damp Proof Courses**
- **Lime Mortar Technology**
